

## Rules and Information

1. Neither Hunt Cap Horse Shows, South Branch Farms, any volunteer or employee, nor the Kinsley Family will be held responsible for any accident, injury, damages or loss to persons, horse/pony, or property of exhibitor or spectator, incurred on or off horse show grounds.
2. **Show entry fees** are \$12 per class
3. The show office will open approximately 1 hour before the show starts. **Please pre-enter to minimize your wait.** Fax entries to 717-767-6154.
4. Pre-entries are appreciated and will be accepted on-line or by fax. There is no fee to scratch, however please notify us if you need to scratch. Please pre-enter by noon two days before the show.
5. There will be a \$25 returned check fee.
6. Schooling in the rings will be allowed, please see individual show time schedules for schooling times. Schooling over the outside course will be allowed at shows offering courses on the outside course.
7. USEF Rules apply where applicable. Protective boots will be allowed on the outside course and humane bit options will be allowed. No martingales permitted on the flat.
8. Decision of the judges and show management is final.
9. Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve Champions will be awarded to two of the four horses/riders who have acquired the most points in their division over fences, only those horses will receive full points for under saddle classes. In the event of a tie the title shall be awarded to the horse/rider with the most points over fences. In flat and cross-rails divisions, all classes will count equally.
10. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, divide or change the order of classes. Three entries are needed to fill a class/division for points to count for year end award..
11. A negative Coggins test, within 1 year, is required.
12. Age of exhibitors will be as of December 1, 2008.
13. Appropriate attire required for each event. Feel free to show at the schooling shows in your lesson attire. Proper protective head gear must be worn at all times while mounted, chin straps for juniors and proper footwear is mandatory.
14. Dogs must be leashed.
15. No stallions on the grounds.

## **Classes Offered** **HUNTER DIVISIONS**

### **SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER DIVISION**

Riders 12 years old or under. To be shown in the ring over 18" fences, no oxers. Riders may not show in classes with fences > 2'.

- 1/2 Short Stirrup Hunter
- 3 Short Stirrup Hunter Under Saddle

### **PRE-CHILDREN'S HUNTER DIVISION**

Open to junior riders. To be shown in the ring over 2' fences. Riders may not show in classes with fences >2'. Horses may show in classes with fences > 2' with another rider.

- 4/5 Pre-Children's Hunter
- 6 Pre-Children's Hunter Under Saddle

### **BEGINNER HUNTER DIVISION**

To be shown in the ring over 2' fences.

- 7/8 Beginner Hunter
- 9 Beginner Hunter Under Saddle

### **CHILDREN'S HUNTER DIVISION**

Open to junior riders. To be shown in the ring over 2'6" fences.

- 10/11/12 Children's Hunter
- 13 Children's Hunter Under Saddle

### **SPECIAL HUNTER DIVISION**

To be shown in the ring over 2'6" or 3' fences.

- 14/15/16 Special Hunter
- 17 Special Hunter Under Saddle

### **FIELD HUNTER CLASSES**

To be shown over the outside course.

- 18 2' Schooling Hunter
- 19 2'6" Schooling Hunter
- 20 3' Schooling Hunter

## **ENGLISH PLEASURE DIVISION**

Will be split into Horse & Pony if entries warrant. Please put a 1 in front of the class number for ponies (entries 14.2 & under) i.e. 121, 122, 123.

- 21 English Pleasure Walk-Trot
- 22/23 English Pleasure
- 24 Cross Country Pleasure - may be asked to jump two cross-rails

## **WALK-TROT DIVISION**

Riders may not cross enter in canter classes. Will be split into 12 & under and Open if entries warrant. Please put 1 in front of the class number for riders 13 years and older eligible for the Open section

- 25/26 Walk-Trot Equitation
- 27/28 Walk-Trot Pleasure

## **EQUITATION DIVISIONS**

### **LEAD-LINE EQUITATION DIVISION**

Open to riders 7 years old and under. May cross enter Mini-Stirrup or Walk-Trot Divisions.

- 29 Lead-Line Walk-Halt
- 30 Lead-Line Walk-Trot
- 31 Advanced Lead-Line - leader to walk beside, off line

### **MINI-STIRRUP EQUITATION DIVISION**

Open to riders 8 years old and under. May cross enter Lead-Line, Walk-Trot and Short-Stirrup Divisions.

- 32 Mini-Stirrup Walk-Halt
- 33 Mini-Stirrup Walk-Trot
- 34 Mini-Stirrup Combined (Walk-trot + 2 Cross-Rails)
- 35 Mini-Stirrup Over Cross-Rails (Designed to trot)

## **SHORT-STIRRUP EQUITATION DIVISION**

Open to riders 12 years old and under. Simple changes allowed.

- 36 Short-Stirrup Walk-Trot
- 37 Short-Stirrup Walk-Trot-Canter
- 38 Short-Stirrup Combined (Walk-Trot-Canter + 2 Cross-Rails)
- 39 Short-Stirrup Over Cross-Rails or small fences

## **LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION DIVISION**

Open to adult and junior riders 13 years and older, not showing in classes with fences greater than 2'. Simple changes allowed.

- 40 Long Stirrup Equitation Walk-Trot
- 41 Long Stirrup Equitation Walk-Trot-Canter
- 42 Long Stirrup Equitation Combined (Walk-Trot-Canter + 2 Cross-Rails)
- 43 Long Stirrup Equitation Over Cross-Rails or small fences

## **"HUNT CAP" EQUITATION ON THE FLAT**

Open to junior riders. To be shown on the flat at the walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring, including extended gaits. Riders may be asked to counter-canter, no more than 8 horses at a time. Addition tests may be used.

- 44 "Hunt Cap" Equitation on the Flat

## **"A BIT MORE TACK" EQUITATION MEDAL**

Open to junior riders. Shown over a course of 2' or 2'6" fences, rider's choice. The top four riders will return for a test as a group or individually.
